


Twelve proposals for the Tiber by Kristin Jones









BIONDO TEVERE

Materials: Acetate Bands, Cable, Hardware

Dimensions: 1800' L x 334' W (549m L x 102m W)

Suspended at street level between Ponte Sisto and Ponte Mazzini, seventy-four parallel bands will run the length of the river site and highlight the simple geometry of the rectangular Piazza Tevere. Biondo Tevere, a shimmering haze of quivering golden ribbons, will reflect onto the water's surface below, dramatizing the play of light and air. Looking up from the river's edge, the luminous saffron mist hovering above the water will visually dissolve with the sky. The movement of air across the bands will activate the work, evoking the sound of a harp.
